Transportation, Utilities and Community Facilities (TUCF) Workgroup Draft Goal and Objectives Statements

This workgroup is charged to work on both the Transportation and Utilities and Community Facilities Elements. Topics covered in the Utilities and Community Facilities Element include: power plants, transmission lines, telecommunication facilities, parks, cemeteries, health care facilities, childcare facilities, sanitary sewer service, on-site wastewater treatment technology, water supply, storm water management, solid waste disposal, recycling, police, fire and rescue, libraries, schools and other governmental facilities. Topics covered in the Transportation Element include: transit, transportation facilities for the disabled, bicycles, walking, railroads, air transportation, trucking and highways. From October 2003 to the present, the workgroup has had ten meetings.
