Subject: Amendment to the *Dane County Water Quality Plan*, revising the Verona Urban Service Area boundary and Environmental Corridors in the Southeast Neighborhood of the City of Verona.

Dear Mr. Mesbah:

We have completed our review of the subject amendment request that was submitted to the Department on July 23, 2010 by the Capital Area Regional Planning Commission. The Department hereby approves this amendment request which adds 78.5 acres to the Verona Urban Service Area, including 2.5 acres of existing right-of-way and 13.4 acres of environmental corridors, for a total addition of 62.7 developable acres. The amendment area is adjacent to the southeast side of the current urban service area, east of USH 151, between Whalen Road and CTH M, in the City of Verona (See Map 1).

The proposed amendment was requested by the City of Verona and was adopted by the Capital Area Regional Planning Commission per Resolution CARPC No. 2010-9 on June 10, 2010.

The approval of this sewer service area amendment does not constitute approval of any other local, state, or federal permit that may be required for sewer construction or associated land development activities.

If you believe that you have a right to challenge this decision, you should know that the Wisconsin statutes and administrative rules establish time periods within which requests to review Department decisions must be filed. For judicial review of a decision pursuant to sections 227.52 and 227.53, Wis. Stats., you have 30 days after the decision is mailed, or otherwise served by the Department, to file your petition with the appropriate circuit court and serve the petition on the Department. Such a petition for judicial review must name the Department of Natural Resources as the respondent.

To request a contested case hearing pursuant to section 227.42, Wis. Stats., you have 30 days after the decision is mailed, or otherwise served by the Department, to serve a petition for hearing on the Secretary of the Department of Natural Resources. All requests for contested case hearings must be made in accordance with section NR 2.05(5), Wis. Adm. Code, and served on the Secretary in accordance with

section NR 2.03, Wis. Adm. Code. The filing of a request for a contested case hearing does not extend the 30 day period for filing a petition for judicial review.

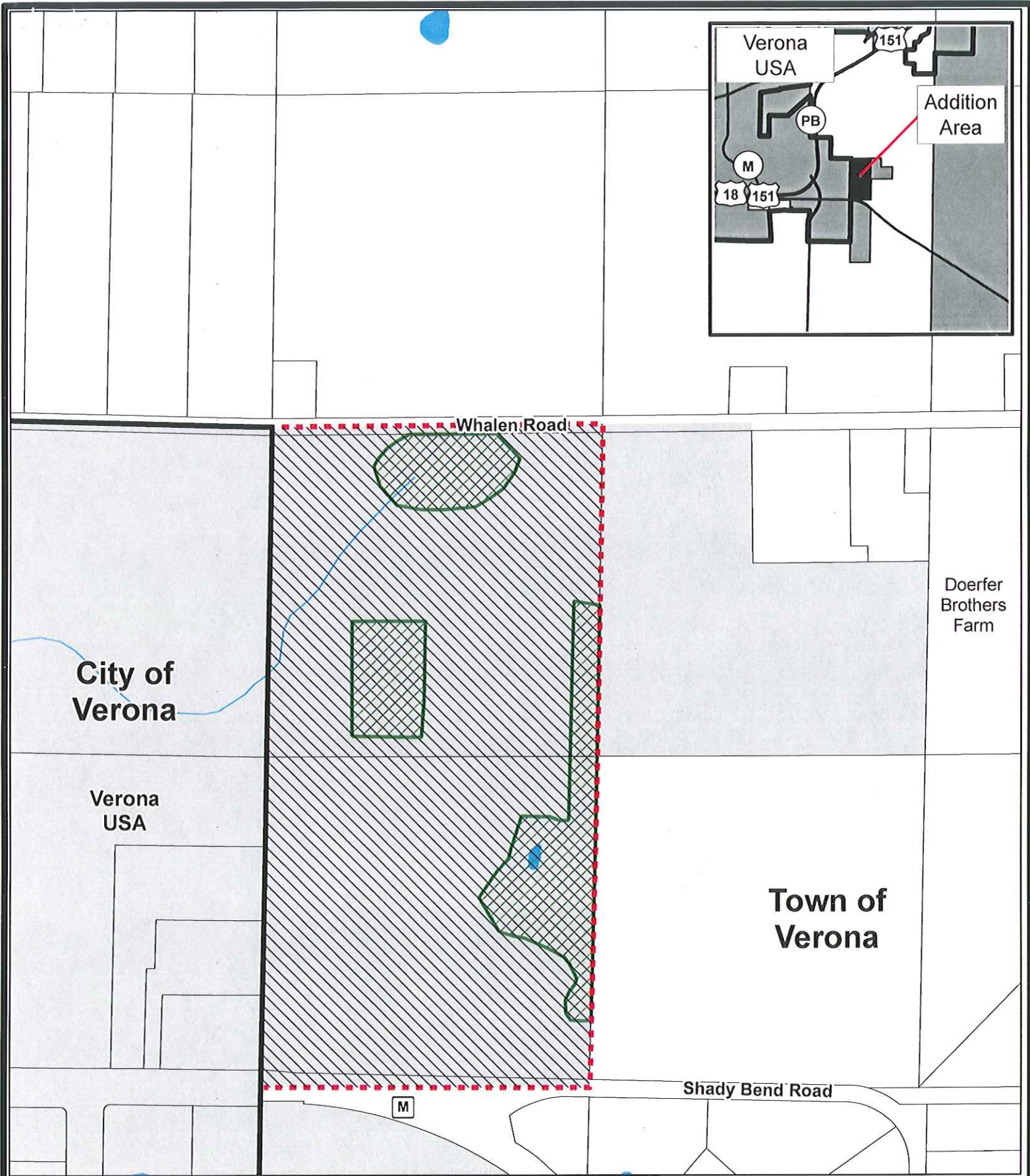


