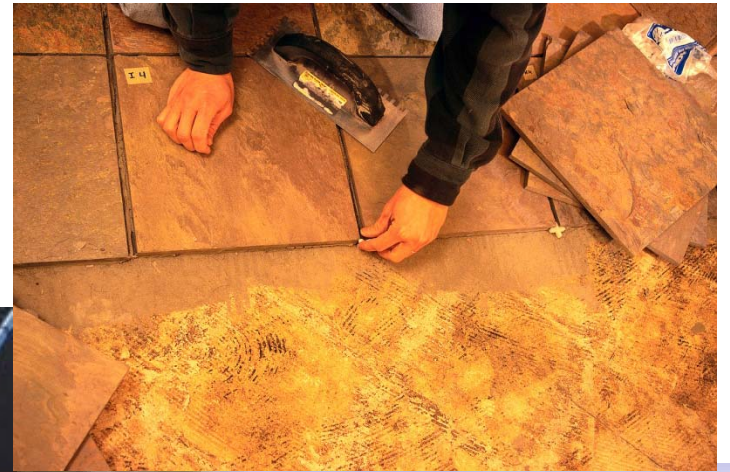

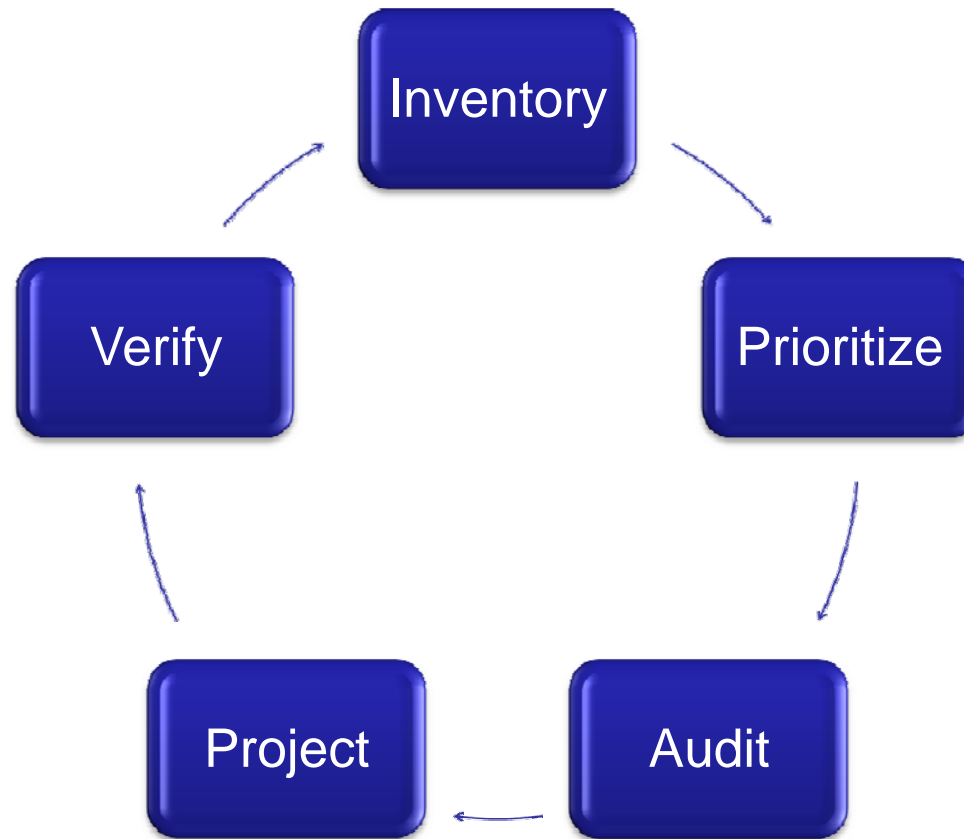

Why Inventory and Benchmarking?

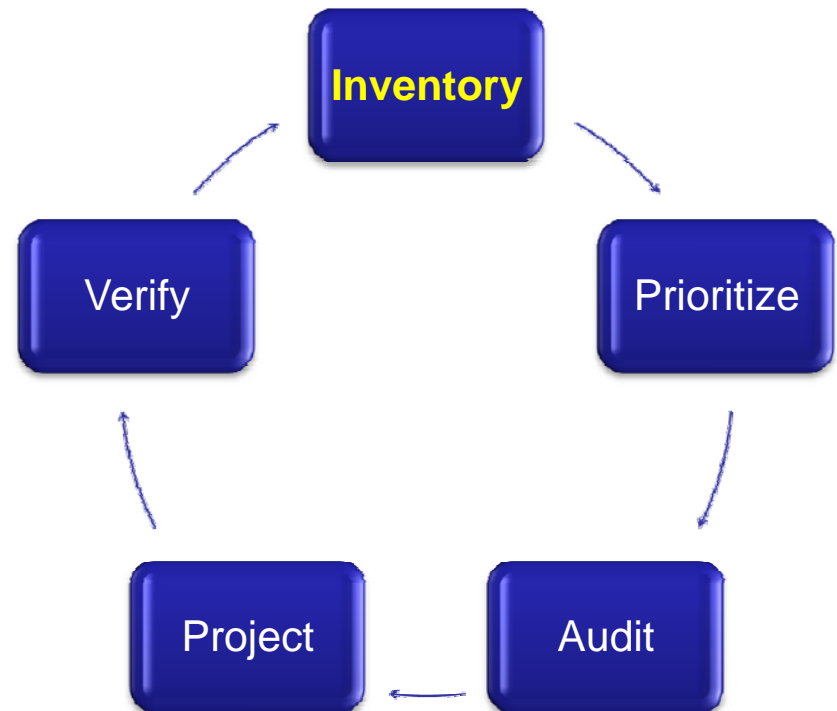
- Identify easiest opportunities to save money on energy budget
- Measure progress and quantify savings
- Communicate with public about successes in saving energy costs
- Attract state and federal monies for energy saving improvements to infrastructure (ex. EECSBG)
- Establishes leadership role for residents to follow

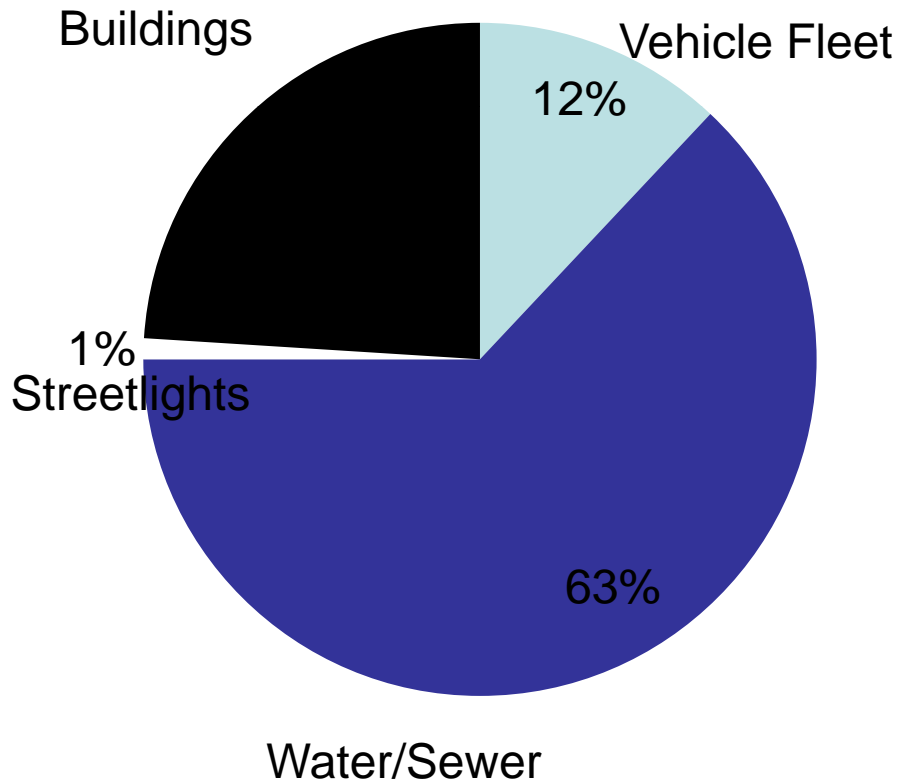

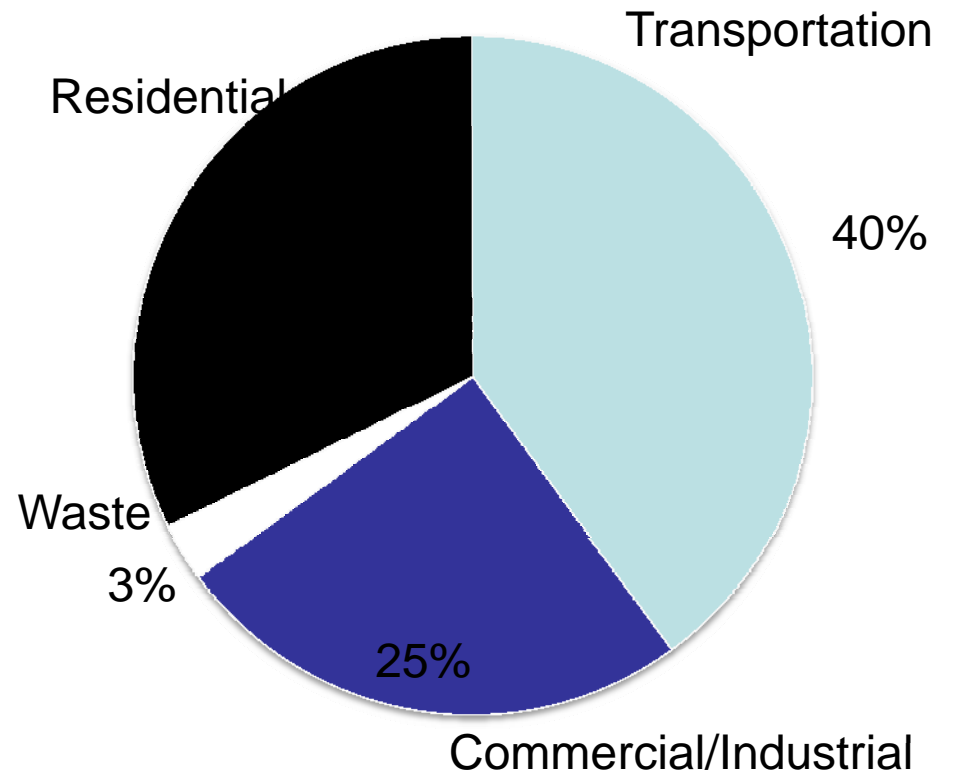

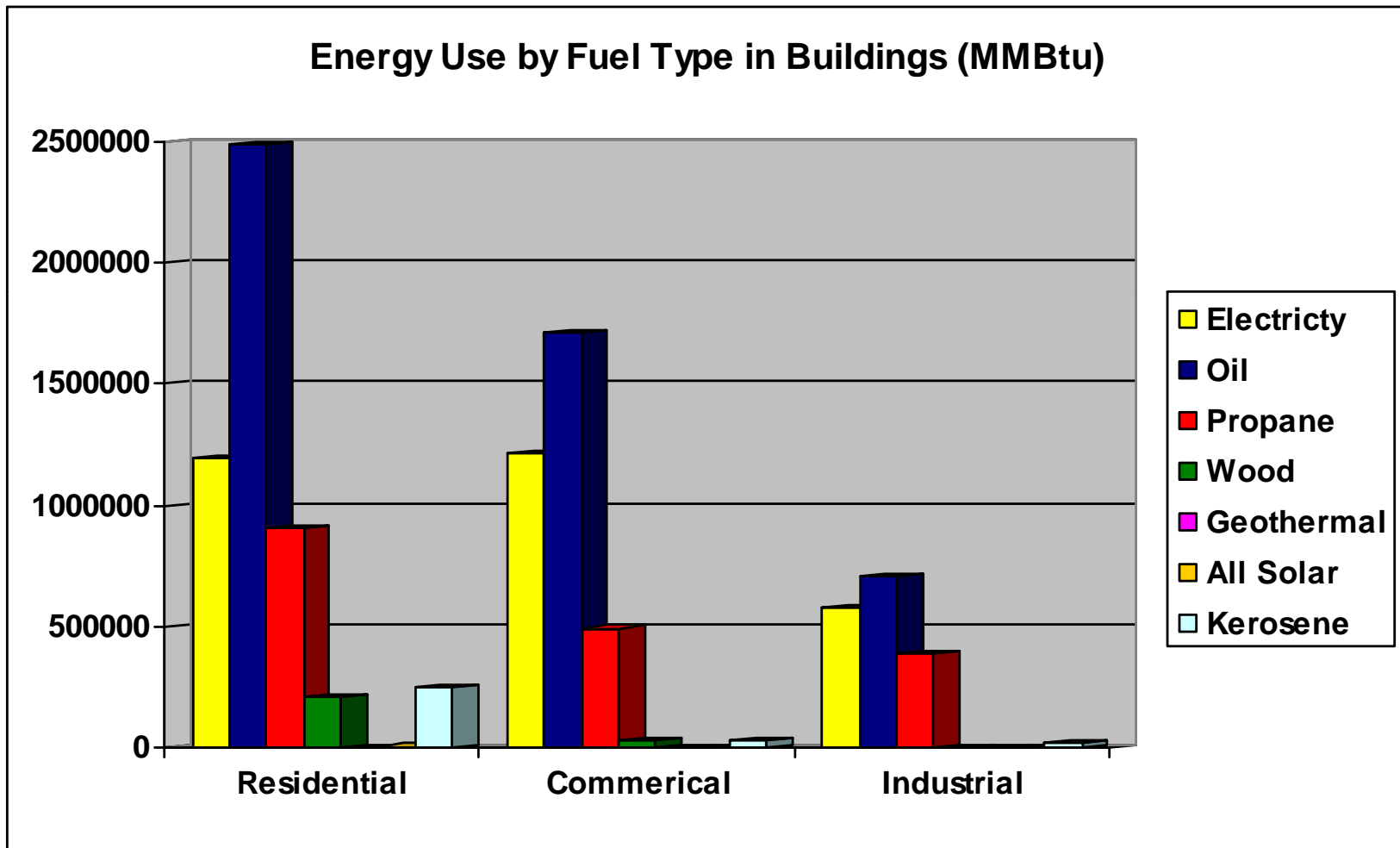


Regional

What we spend as a region on heating our homes, water and cooking...

- Electricity: \$4,208,367
- Heating Oil: **\$68,321,942**
- Propane: \$20,897,563

Propane (us gal): \$2.155

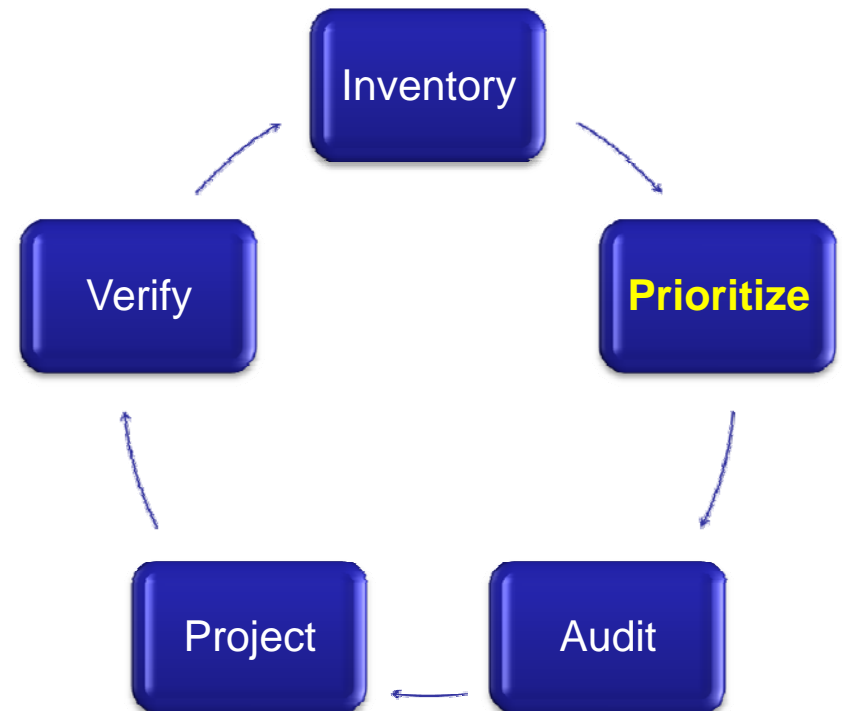
If we reduced what we spent on residential energy in our buildings across the region by 30% we could afford to...

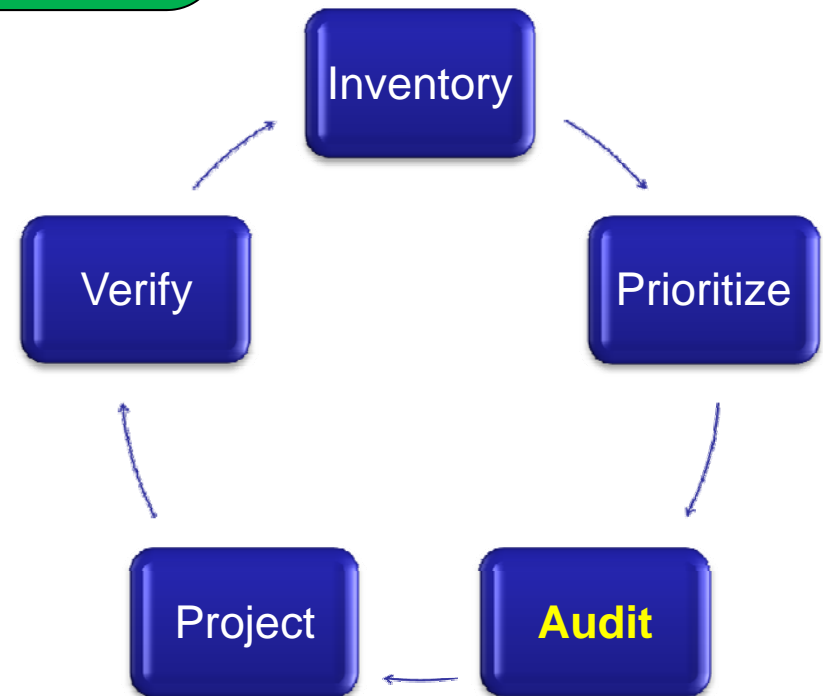

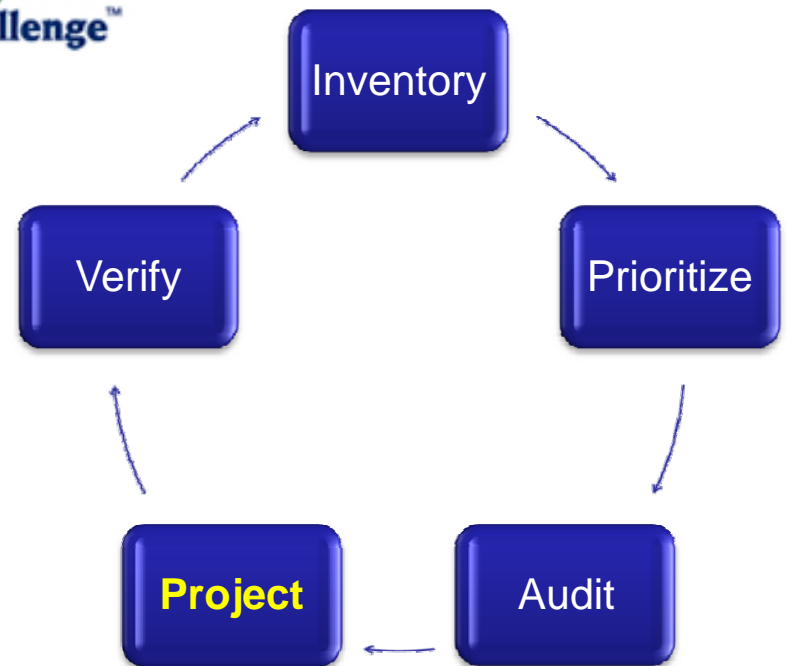
