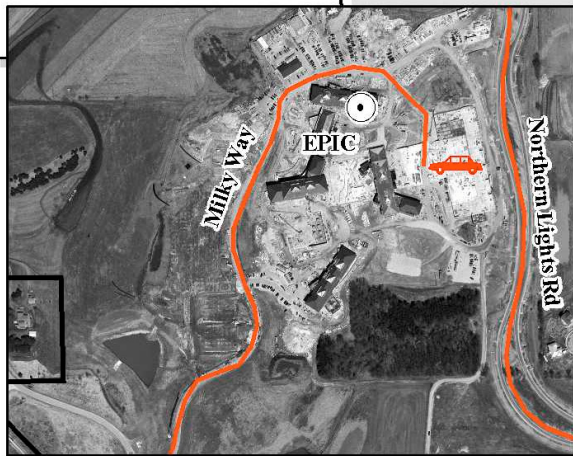
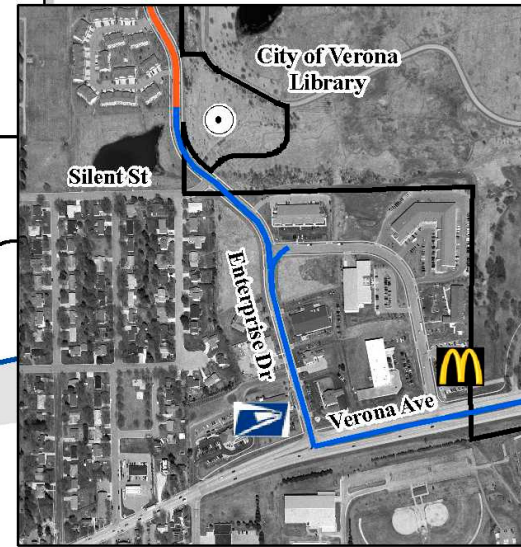
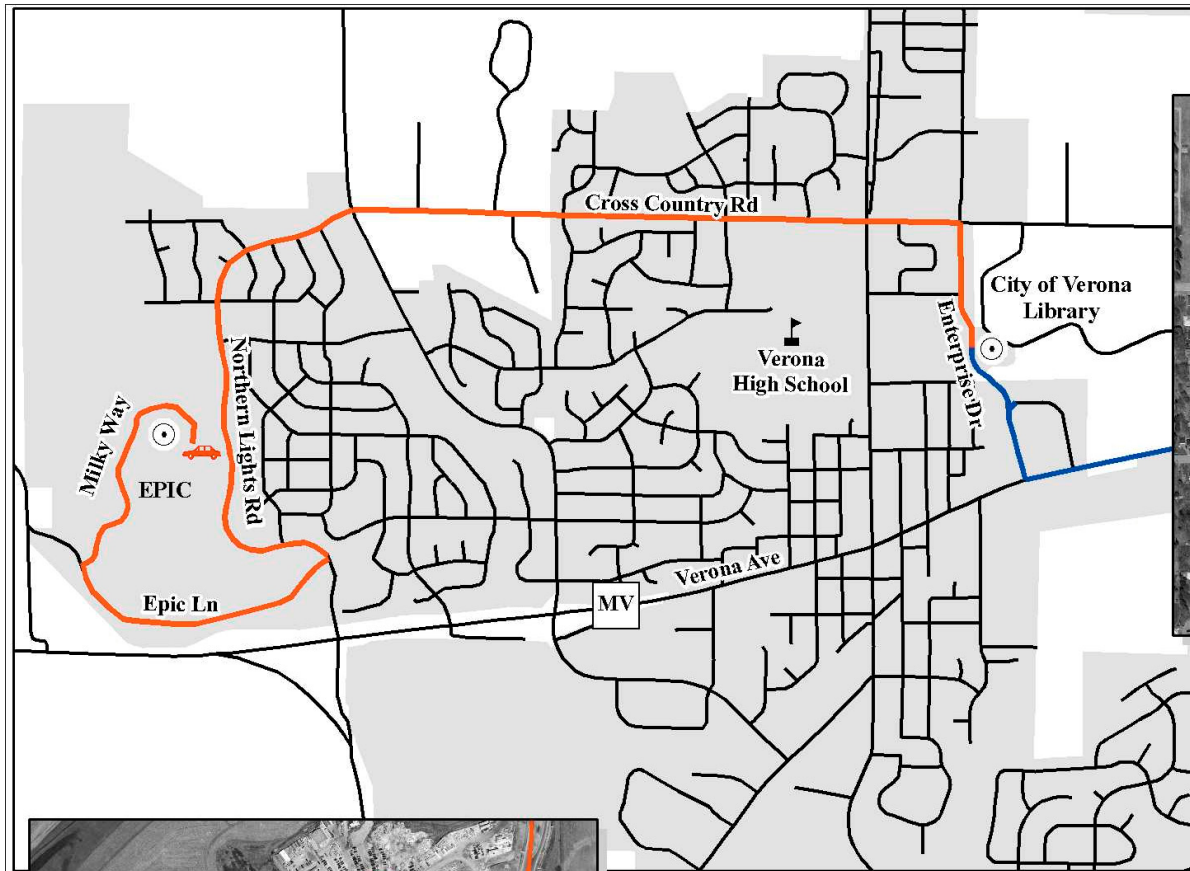

Directions to the City of Verona Library (500 Silent St)

Coming from Madison or Mt. Horeb along U.S. Highway 18/151, use Exit 81 which leads to County Highway MV/Verona Ave. Traveling east on Verona Ave turn right onto Enterprise Dr after the McDonalds but before the Post Office. Traveling north on Enterprise Dr, the library will be on the right.

Directions from the City of Verona Library to EPIC

Exit the library parking lot and turn right (north) on Enterprise Dr.
 Turn left (west) on Cross Country Rd.
 At the intersection of Cross Country Rd and N. Nine Mound Rd continue west onto Northern Lights Rd.
 After traveling south on Northern Lights Rd and passing EPIC buildings on the right; turn right (west) on Epic Ln.
 Epic Ln will give you a tour of the southern portion of the campus.
 Turn right (north) onto Milky Way, continue on Milky Way until you arrive at the visitor parking deck in front of the Ganymede and Andromeda buildings.
