

NOTICE OF INTENT TO REMOVE CHILD(REN)

MOVING THE CHILD'S RESIDENCE WITHIN OR OUTSIDE THE STATE: WI Stats. 767.481

(1) NOTICE TO OTHER PARENT.

(a) If the court grants periods of physical placement to more than one parent, it shall order a parent with legal custody of and physical placement rights to a child to provide not less than 60 days written notice to the other parent, with a copy to the court, of his or her intent to:

- 1) Establish his or her legal residence with the child at any location outside the state
- 2) Establish his or her legal residence with the child at any location within this state that is at a distance of 150 miles or more from the other parent.
- 3) Remove the child from the state for more than 90 consecutive days

2. Send a copy, by Certified Mail, to the other parent.

You must include:

- a) the proposed action
- b) the specific date and location of the move or/
- c) specific beginning and ending dates and location of the removal
- d) notice to the other parent that he or she may object within 15 days after receiving the Notice

3. Keep a copy for yourself.

IF THERE IS AN OBJECTION FROM THE OTHER PARENT:

Within 15 days after receiving the notice, the other parent may send to the parent proposing the move or removal, with a copy to the court, a written notice of objection to the proposed action.

If the parent who is proposing the move or removal receives a notice of objection within 20 days after sending a "Notice of Intent to Remove," the parent may NOT move with or remove the child pending resolution of the dispute or final order of the court unless the parent obtains a temporary order to do so.

The Court, upon receipt of a copy of the Notice of Objection, shall promptly refer the parents for mediation or other family court services and may appoint a Guardian ad litem. Unless the parents agree to extend the time period, if mediation or family court services do not resolve the dispute within 30 days after referral, the matter shall proceed as outlined in WI Stat. 767.481, Sec 3-5m.
