

CONSTRUCTION SUPERINTENDENT

DEFINITION

Under general supervision of the Highway Commissioner or Assistant Highway Commissioner to be responsible for the supervision and quality control of all work performed by the field construction crews; and to do related work as required.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES

Performs and supervises testing and inspection procedures and assists in scheduling of projects performed by Highway Department personnel and private contracting firms; directs the work of survey crews and participates as a surveyor when needed at construction sites; assists the Associate Highway Engineer in the design, preparation of plans, and cost estimates for all types of highway projects including structures and pavement design; works with the Highway Maintenance Superintendent in the scheduling of personnel and as an advisor for highway maintenance problems.

EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS

Education and Experience: Any combination of training and experience equivalent to a bachelor's degree in civil engineering and one year of road construction management experience.

Knowledges and Abilities: Knowledge of highway and related structure construction and maintenance; knowledge of construction and maintenance materials and mixes; knowledge of highway equipment used; knowledge of CADD system desirable; ability to supervise skilled trades personnel as well as unskilled workers; ability to plan, organize, assign work, and follow up to see that completed work is up to standard.

Special Requirements: Must have (or be eligible for) valid Wisconsin Driver's License.
