

DRAFTSPERSON

DEFINITION

Under general supervision, to perform responsible, skilled, paraprofessional engineering drafting and computations; and to do related work as required.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES

Performs drafting and computations involved in preparing plans as they relate to buildings, mechanical systems, utilities, sanitary landfills and related facilities; assists in the preparation of construction plans, field inspections, and surveying work; computes material quantities; and other engineering functions.

EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS

Education and Experience: Any combination equivalent to one year of work experience in drafting or one year of vocational school engineering course work which included courses in drafting.

Knowledges and Abilities: Ability to make accurate engineering drawings using drafting equipment; ability to interpret plans and specifications and to use basic engineering mathematics; knowledge of land surveying techniques is desirable.

Special Requirements: Must have (or be eligible for) a valid Wisconsin driver's license.
