

# PARK MAINTENANCE WORKER

## DEFINITION

Under direction, to construct, inspect, maintain and repair buildings and other park relative facilities; to operate a variety of tools, equipment and motorized vehicles; and to do related work as required.

## EXAMPLES OF DUTIES

Primary emphasis is upon carpentry knowledge and skill in working independently to perform construction, inspection, maintenance, and repair tasks or assisting others in the performance of more difficult electrical or building trades repair work; occasionally makes work assignments and directs other employees in specific tasks; operates motorized vehicles including trucks, snow plows, tractors, and mowers; performs concrete and asphalt work, painting, plumbing, layout work and record keeping; performs roofing; constructs play areas and maintains buildings and facilities.

## EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS

Education and Experience: Must be able to read and write and have any combination equivalent to two years experience in carpentry, construction, and closely related tasks, using standard hand and power tools.

Knowledges and Abilities: Knowledge of materials, practices, tools, and method used in the construction, maintenance, and repair of buildings and other park related facilities; knowledge of operation of heating, plumbing, electrical and ventilating systems; ability to plan work using sketches, layouts, and blueprints, ability to keep records and make reports; ability to operate motorized vehicles; ability to use standard hand and power tools; ability to communicate tactfully and courteously with the public and fellow employees; knowledge of occupational safety hazards and safe work methods; ability to perform physical tasks and related work as required.

Special Requirements: Must have or be eligible for a valid Wisconsin class "A" commercial driver's license. Must also be available for work on weekends, and holidays and for work anywhere within Dane County.
