Dear Concerned Citizens,

It has come to our attention that the Wisconsin Homeowners Alliance, paid for by the Wisconsin Realtors Association, has mailed postcards suggesting that we are taking action on a plan or ordinance amendments. As Chair of the Urban Runoff Committee of the Lakes & Watershed Commission, I want to assure you that no such action is pending. To underscore that I made the motion below at the Commission's meeting last Thursday.

I move that the final grant report be sent to the DNR after next week's public comment sessions, and the public be assured at those meetings that the Lakes and Watersheds Commission and county will take no action on implementing the plan until we see the final state requirements to comply with NR 115.

It was seconded by Supervisor Hulsey and passed unanimously. I hope with this assurance we can move forward with a healthy exchange of information regarding impacts on our lakes and streams and how we can work together to better care for them.
