Questions and answers provided below in response to questions received.

- Question #1* It appears there is a lifetime maximum on transplants and calendar year on kidney. Does Dane County have a special exemption from the PPACA and if so, for how long? Our understanding is that the transplant lifetime maximum would have to be removed upon renewal at latest, 1/1/11, and the calendar year (“annual”) maximum on kidney. Is this correct?
- Answer #1 The answers to this question are answered in Addendum 1, question 1, letter a.
- Question #2* Does the \$5 copay in the HMO design family column mean that single contract doesn't pay or are the single and family columns are the same unless otherwise noted?

- Question #3* Acupuncture – states “specific diagnosis limitation” –which diagnoses are covered?

- Question #4* Is the ER copay –waived if admitted?
- Answer #4 The answers to this question are answered in Addendum 1, question 1, letter d.
- Question #5* What are the difference between the home health services and home health therapies benefits? 100 for one and 40 for the other? Are there differences?
- Answer #5 The answers to this question are answered in Addendum 1, question 1, letter e.
- Question #6* For POS design, please confirm the \$200 max oop on office visits applies only to in network copays, as deductible would prevail on out of network and the two would

not accumulate together.

Answer #6 The answers to this question are answered in Addendum 1, question 1, letter f.

Question #7 *In the Insurance Questionnaire section there is the following question: “Will you allow a County designee on your grievance committee? Yes or no?” Does Dane County mean they want a designee from the County to always be on the grievance committee or only when a Dane County employee has filed a grievance?*

Answer #7 Dane County would like to have a representative on the committee for all grievances. The member would not be able to vote on grievances from Dane County employees.
