- **Adults are encouraged to attend** (even if you have taken a safety class in the past). Many insurance providers offer discounts for completing this course.
- There is a book to read (given at class), and a multiple choice test at the end of the course.
- While the minimum age is 10, it is recommended that students are closer to 12 years of age or older (due to reading/comprehension requirements).
- Graduates receive a DNR boating safety certificate valid once the graduate is 12 years old.

**Registration:** Please register prior to class. (Some locations have limited seating.) The cost is \$10.00, collected at class.
