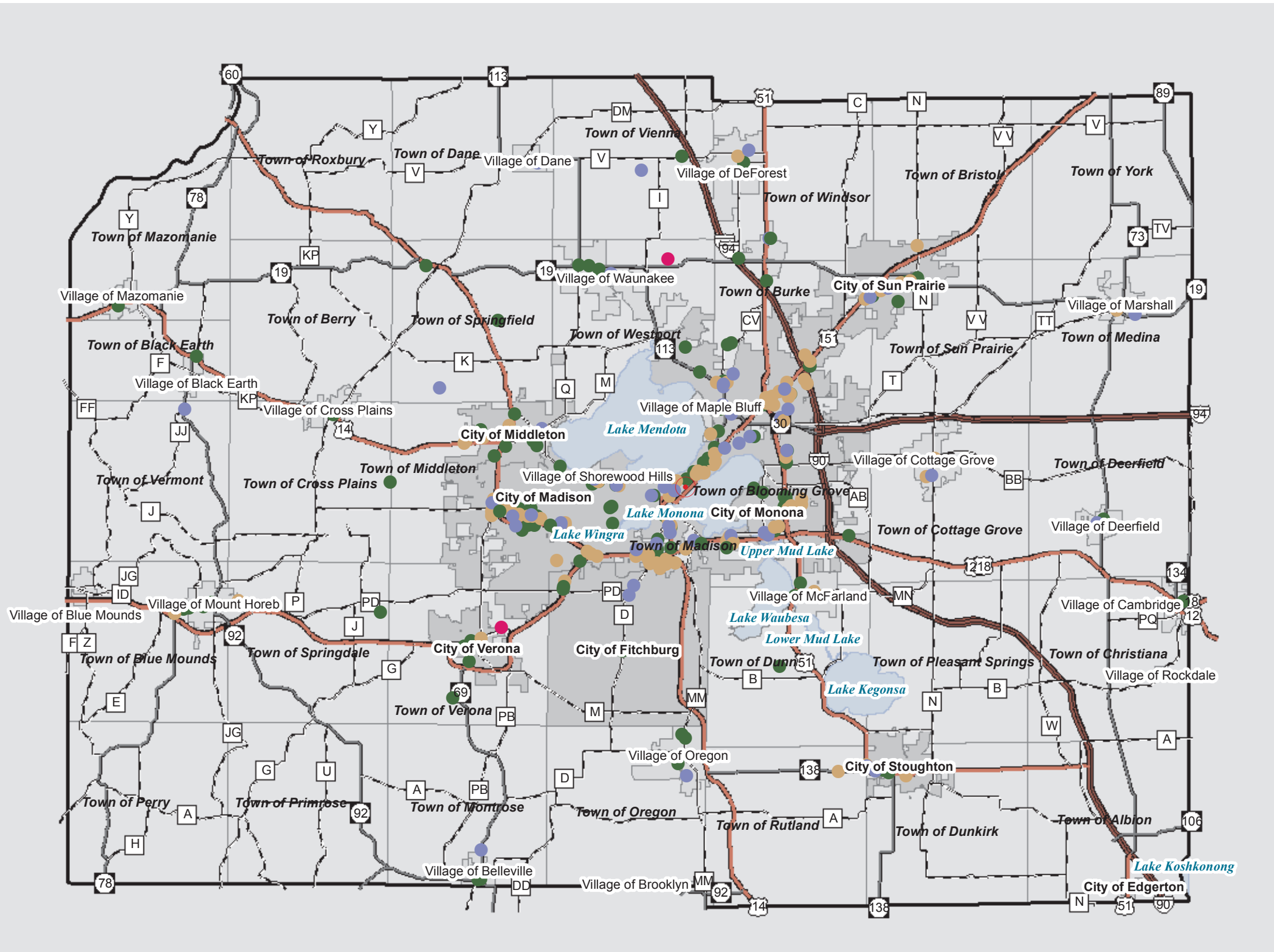

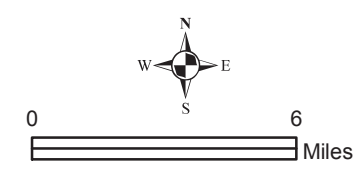

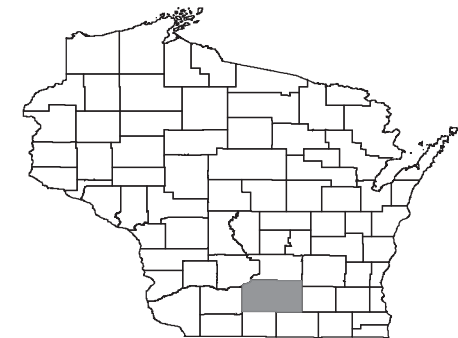
### What you're looking at:

Recycling locations were digitized based on published locations compiled by the Dane County Public Works, Department of Highway and Transportation. Some examples of materials that can be recycled are: antifreeze, oil, appliances, asphalt and concrete, pallets, barrels and drums, paper, plastic (foam or rigid), carpet padding, plastic bags, cell phones, rendering, clothing and cloth scraps, salvage computer and electronics, reuse/recycling shingles, corrugated cardboard, solvents, drywall, styrofoam peanuts, fluorescent and incandescent lamps and bulbs, thermostats, glass, tires, metal, and wood.
