**AMENDING CHAPTER 7 OF THE DANE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES,
REGARDING WITHDRAWAL OF PENDING MATTERS FROM COMMITTEE**

The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Dane does ordain as follows:

ARTICLE 1. Unless otherwise expressly stated herein, all references to section and chapter numbers are to those of the Dane County Code of Ordinances.

ARTICLE 2. Section 7.54(2) is amended to read as follows:

(2) A supervisor may move to withdraw a resolution, ordinance or ordinance amendment from the committee(s) to which it was referred by the county board chair or county clerk. A motion to withdraw from committee may be made at a county board meeting only after at least 45 days have elapsed from the date of referral and the motion will be placed on the calendar for the next regular county board meeting. If the motion is approved by a majority vote of the supervisors present at that meeting, the resolution, ordinance or ordinance amendment shall be placed on the calendar for the next regular county board meeting for action. However, for a resolution, ordinance, or ordinance amendment referred to committee by the county board, a motion to withdraw from committee may be made anytime.
